May is National Walk week and this year there are many events happening to support walking in Telford.

The events team at Telford & Wrekin Council, together with the Friends of the Telford T50 50 Mile trail, have put together a comprehensive programme of walks for all ages at all times of the day to enable people to come together in all parts of the town

You can enjoy a walk with friends and family, meet new people and explore the many walks and routes throughout the town. For more information about the entire programme go to **VisitTelford** for full details of this very exciting programme.

From the Tuesday, all the regular Ramblers Wellbeing walks are included in the programme and **EMAIL** for more information. All the new 23 circular Coronation Walks will be led during the week. All these walks are free and are short in length from less than 2 miles to no more than 5.

The T50 Relay Challenge is normally run, but this year 20 walkers from Wellington Walkers are Welcome will walk the relay on Saturday 25th May. I think most, if not all, the walkers will be over 50 and many over 70. Most would put that down to the fact they love walking and the health benefits it provides. They are doing this as part of the national Walkers are Welcome "celebrate your local paths in May" event.

If any of the members of Forum 50+ have completed the T50, no matter how long it has taken, they can request a PDF certificate and can also purchase a medal for £3.00.

WCDS operate a free of charge e-cargo bike delivery service on market days within a 3 mile radius of central Wellington.

We have 14 volunteers and the service works well but we'd like to engage with those that might need the service most, those who may be housebound or unable to lug heavy shopping home.

It is service with a smile, free to all (although we do accept tips for bike maintenance, bad weather clothing etc)

## We ALL SAND together

### Will you help SAND?

Lesbian, gay, bisexual and trans (LGBT+) people in Shropshire, Telford & Wrekin, aged 50-100+, are invited to join SAND in some discussions to identify a whole range of questions that may arise around particular themes, such as: Ageing without children; Housing; Well-being; Money; Legal considerations and Care, which are also being explored in a series of online discussions.

The thoughts and ideas arising from the face-to-face and the online sessions will then be collated into a 'Frequently Asked Questions' resource alongside the details of organisations which may be able to help people to find the answers!

To get the thought-processes going - some of the questions already shared with us include:

- who is going to look out for my interests in 10, 20 or 30 years' time?
- what are my options if home maintenance starts stressing me out?
- what if I have a temporary health condition which means it is hard for me to cope at home in the short term?
- are there any implications of not being married or in a Civil Partnership?
- how does anyone pay for the care that they need?

Online sessions take place each evening week beginning Mon 20 May, 7:20pm-8pm. Face-to-face sessions are at Palmer's of Shrewsbury Sat 8 June 10am-12pm and Poetry Pharmacy, Bishop's Castle, Sun 7 July, 10am-12pm.




